Sub: Advancement of Southwest monsoon over Northeast India

- ◆ Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into more parts of Central Arabian Sea, some more parts of Maharashtra, entire Karnataka, some more parts of Talengana, entire Tamilnadu, some more parts of Andhra Pradesh, more parts of Central Bay of Bengal and northeast Bay of Bengal and thence **entire northeastern states of India (Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Assam & Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh), most parts of Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim today, the 6th June 2021.**

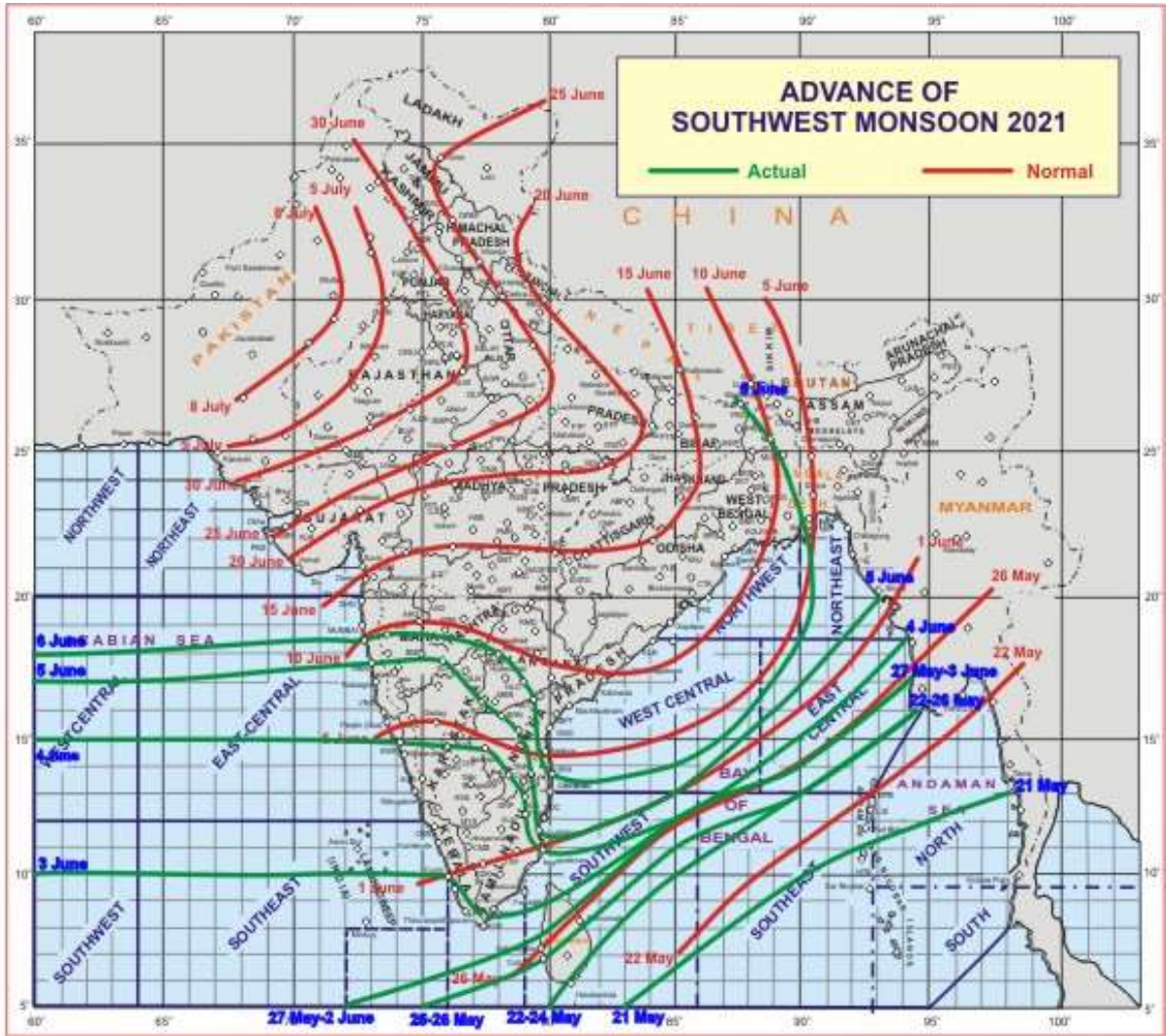


Fig 1: Advancement of Southwest Monsoon 2021

- ◆ The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) passes through Lat. 18.0°N/Long. 65.0° E, Lat. 18.5°N/Long. 70.0° E, Alibagh, Pune, Medak, Nalgonda, Rentachintala, Sriharikota, Lat. 14.0°N/Long. 85.0° E, Lat. 16.0°N/Long. 88.0° E, Lat. 20.0°N/Long. 90.5° E, and Lat. 24.0°N/Long. 89.5° E and Bagdogra (**Fig. 1**)
- ◆ Light to moderate rainfall occurred at most places over the meteorological sub-divisions of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland-Manipur-Mizoram & Tripura.
- ◆ Stations of Northeast Region that received rainfall (3 cm or more) during the last 24 hours ending at 0830 hrs IST of 06.06.2021 are as follows-
