Subject: Heavy rainfall over Northeastern States during next 4-5 days

• **Realised rainfall over Northeastern States during last 24 hours:**

Widespread rainfall activity observed over the North-eastern states with heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls (≥ 20 cm) at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya; heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura and isolated heavy rainfall over Arunachal Pradesh subdivisions during past 24 hours.

• **Weather forecast for next 5 days:**

The current Meteorological analysis and numerical model guidance suggests that fairly widespread to widespread rainfall activity is most likely over the North-Eastern states during next 5 days.

• **Heavy rainfall warning:**

- Heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy falls is most likely at isolated places especially over Meghalaya & parts of West Assam on 12th; heavy to very heavy falls on 13th and isolated heavy rainfall over rest parts of Assam during same period. Isolated heavy falls is also most likely to occur over Assam & Meghalaya on 14th, 15th & 16th August 2017.
- Heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh on 12th & 13th August 2017 and decrease thereafter.
- Heavy to very heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura subdivision on 12th and heavy rainfall at isolated places on 13th & 14th August 2017.
