Subject: Decrease in rainfall activity over Northeastern states during next 5 days

• **Rainfall activity over Northeastern states during last week:**

- Fairly Widespread to Widespread rainfall occurred over the region during most of the days.
- Heavy to very heavy rainfall with isolated extremely heavy falls observed at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya and Arunachal Pradesh; isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall observed over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on many days.

After this intense spell of rainfall activity, current Meteorological analysis and Numerical Weather Model guidance suggest decrease in the rainfall activity over the region, both in the spatial distribution and intensity during next 04-05 days; however isolated heavy falls are likely in some parts of the region during the same period.

• **Weather forecast for next 5 days:**

- Rain/thundershowers are very likely at most places over Arunachal Pradesh on 13th August 2017 and decrease thereafter.
- Rain/thundershowers are very likely at most places over Assam & Meghalaya on 13th & 14th August 2017 and decrease thereafter.
- Rain/thundershowers are very likely at most places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 13th & 14th August 2017 and decrease thereafter; however it is likely to increase again from 17th August 2017 onwards.

• **Heavy rainfall warning:**

- Heavy to very heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya on 13th & 14th and isolated heavy falls on 15th, 16th & 17th August 2017.
- Heavy to very heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places especially over Tripura & Mizoram on 13th & 14th and isolated heavy falls over rest parts of Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura and decrease thereafter.
- Heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh on 13th August 2017 and decrease thereafter.
