Subject: Decrease in rainfall activity over North-Eastern States

Rainfall activity over North-Eastern States during last week:

- Fairly Widespread to Widespread rainfall activity occurred over the region on most of the days.
- Heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places observed over the region especially over Arunachal Pradesh and Assam & Meghalaya on many days.
- Southwest Monsoon was active over Arunachal Pradesh for few days during the week.

After this intense spell of rainfall activity, current Meteorological analysis and Numerical Weather Model guidance suggest a significant decrease in the rainfall activity over the region, both in the spatial distribution and rainfall intensity during next 04-05 days.

Weather forecast for next 5 days:

- Rain/thundershowers are very likely at few places over Arunachal Pradesh and Assam & Meghalaya.
- However, rain/thundershowers are likely at many places over the Meteorological Sub-division of Nagaland-Manipur-Mizoram & Tripura during 13th-15th July 2017 and thereafter the spatial distribution of precipitation is likely to decrease during 16th-17th July 2017.

Heavy rainfall warning:

- Heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places over Meghalaya & South Assam, Tripura, Mizoram & South Manipur on 13th July 2017.
