Subject: Advancement of SW Monsoon & Monsoon Activity over North-East India

- The Southwest Monsoon-2019 has further advanced into some parts of central Arabian sea, remaining parts of Kerala, some parts of Karnataka, Tamilnadu, most parts of southwest Bay of Bengal, **some more parts of central & north Bay of Bengal and north-east India** today, the 14th June 2019.
- Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) now passes through Lat. 13°N/Long. 60°E, Lat. 13°N/Long. 70°E, Mangalore, Mysore, Salem, Cuddalore, Lat. 14°N/Long. 86°E, Lat. 20°N/Long. 90°E, Agartala, Lumding, Passighat and Lat. 29°N/Long. 97°E.
- Conditions are becoming favourable for further advance of Southwest Monsoon into some more parts of central Arabian Sea, Karnataka, remaining parts of Tamilnadu, some more parts of central Bay, north & south Bay and some more parts of northeast India and some parts of north Bengal and Sikkim in 2-3 days.
- Southwest Monsoon was active over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura subdivision during past 24 hours.

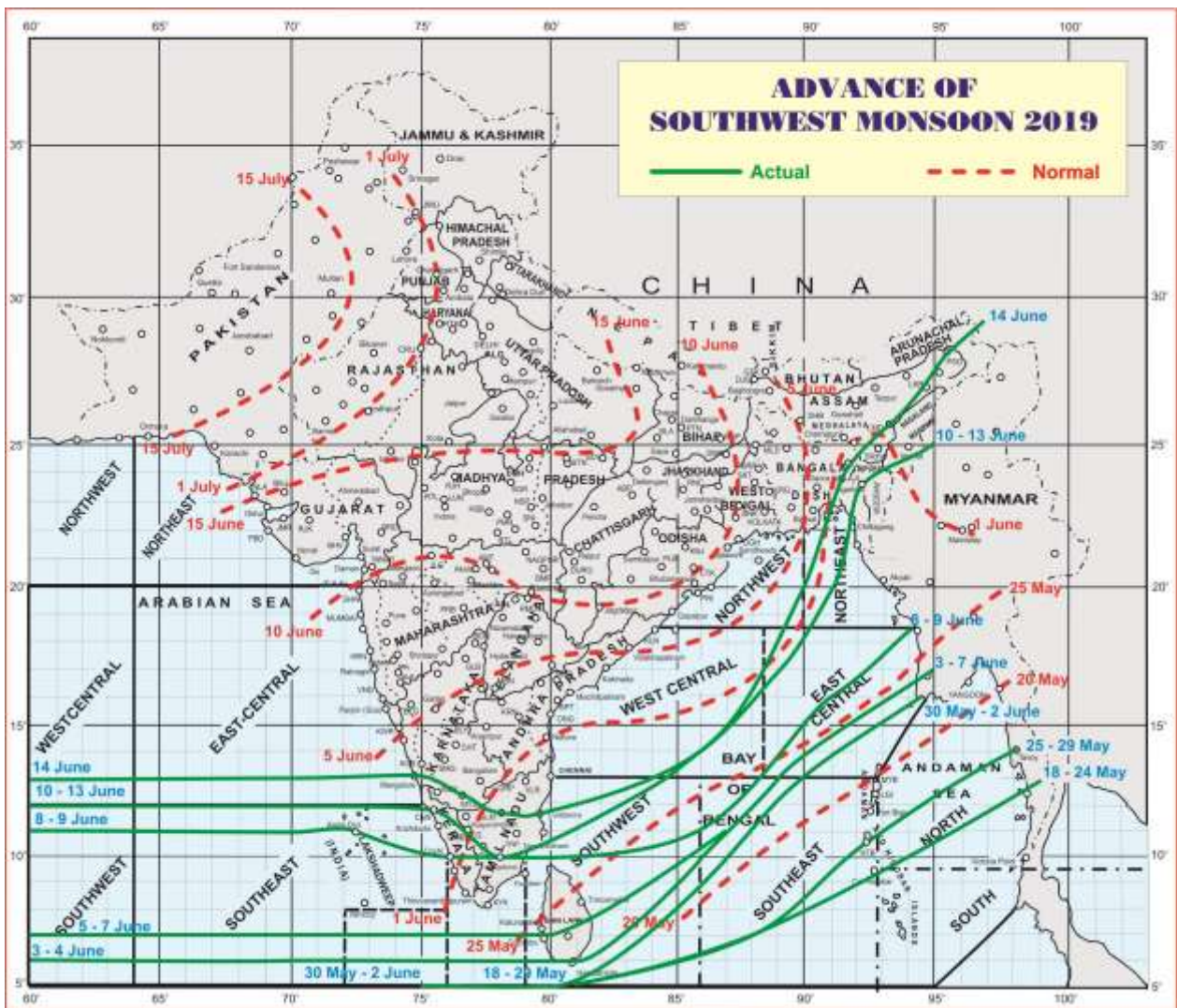


Fig: Northern Limit of South West Monsoon-2019 as on 14th June 2019
