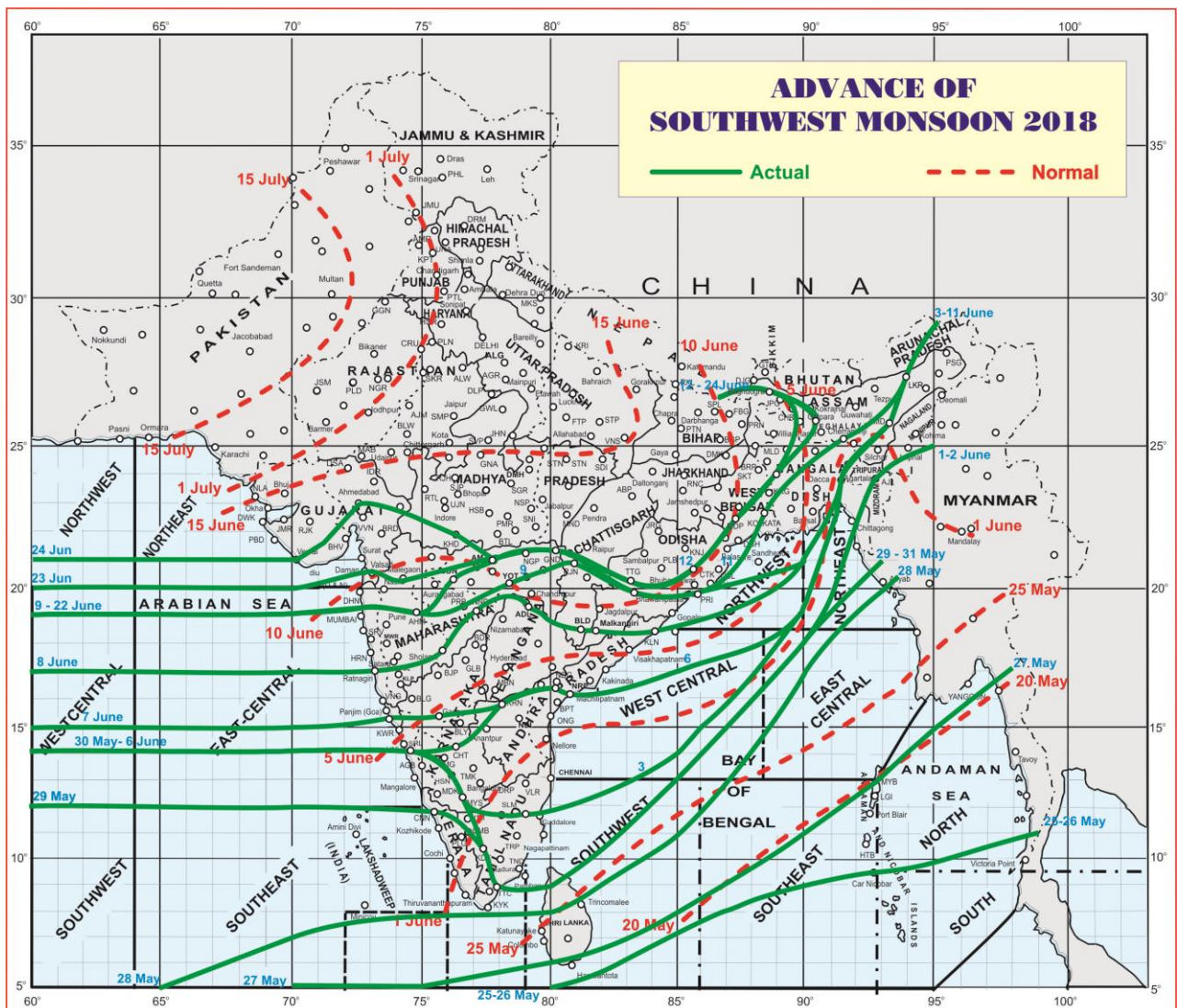

**Sub: Advance of Monsoon & Monsoon Activity over North-Eastern states**

- The Southwest Monsoon-2018 has further advanced into the remaining parts of Assam & Meghalaya and covered entire north-eastern region of the country.
- The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) passes through Lat. 21°N /Long. 60°E, Lat. 21°N /Long. 65°E, Veraval, Amreli, Ahmedabad, Khandwa, Amravati, Gondia, Titlagarh, Cuttak, Midnapore, Lat. 24°N /Long. 89°E, Jalpaiguri and Lat. 27°N /Long. 87°E.
- Southwest Monsoon was active over Arunachal Pradesh; normal over Assam & Meghalaya and weak over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura subdivisions during past 24 hours.
