Subject: Widespread rainfall activity over Northeastern States during next 5 days

Rainfall over northeastern States during past 24 hours:

Widespread rainfall activity with isolated heavy falls observed over Assam & Meghalaya and Arunachal Pradesh, whereas the activity was Fairly Widespread over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during past 24 hours.

Weather forecast for next 5 days:

The current weather analysis and numerical model guidance suggests rain/thundershowers are most likely at most places over the North-Eastern states.

Heavy rainfall warning:

- Heavy to very heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh on 30th June & 01st July 2017 and intensity of precipitation is likely to decrease thereafter and heavy rainfall is likely at isolated places during 02nd-04th July 2017.
- Heavy to very heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya during 30th June – 03rd July 2017 with isolated extremely heavy falls during 30th June – 02nd July 2017 and intensity of precipitation is likely to decrease thereafter.
- Heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 30th June 2017 & 04th July 2017; whereas intensity of precipitation is likely to be more with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 01st - 03rd June 2017.
