Subject: Heavy rainfall activity over Northeastern States during next 5 days

- **Realised rainfall over Northeastern States during past 24 hours:**

Fairly Widespread rainfall activity with isolated heavy falls observed over Assam & Meghalaya and Arunachal Pradesh and Widespread over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during past 24 hours. Associated with this rainfall activity Monsoon Activity was active in Assam & Meghalaya and normal in Arunachal Pradesh and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during last 24 hours.

- **Weather forecast for next 5 days:**

The current weather analysis and numerical model guidance suggests a significant increase in the spatial distribution as well as intensity of the rainfall over the region and rain/thundershowers are very likely at most places over the North-Eastern states.

- **Heavy rainfall warning:**

- Heavy to very heavy rainfall is most likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh during next 4 days i.e. 07th to 10th August 2017 and rainfall activity decrease thereafter.
- Heavy to very heavy rainfall is most likely at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya on 07th & 08th and intensity of rainfall increase thereafter. Heavy to very heavy rainfall with isolated extremely heavy falls is most likely at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya during 09th-11th August 2017.
- Heavy rainfall is most likely at isolated places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 07th & 08th August 2017 and intensity of rainfall increase thereafter. Heavy to very heavy rainfall is most likely at isolated places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 09th-11th August 2017.
